PASCAGOULA, Miss. – James Howard Dungan, age 56, of Pascagoula, Mississippi, died Friday, October 18, 2019, at his home surrounded by his family.

Born July 16, 1963, in Richmond, Indiana, to Frank and Lorraine Klein Dungan, Jim grew up in this community. He was a 1981 graduate of Richmond High School and earned an associate degree in electronic engineering from Ivy Tech Community College in 2001. Jim served in the U.S. Army from 1985-1994. He later served as a police officer in LaGrange, Georgia, from 2004-2010 and at the Troup County Sheriff's Office from 2011-2012. Jim was a member of the Marine Corps League in Richmond and the Singing River Yacht Club and was a former Mason. Most of all, Jim loved spending time with his family and friends. He never met a stranger.
